Dark red color. Distinctive aromas of pomegranate, orange blossoms, cranberry, cherry, raspberry, vanilla bean, and sage unite to create a pleasurable experience. The purity of aromas carries into the palate seamlessly, only slightly intensifying the red fruit profile. With the gentle weather patterns of 2013, this Pinot Noir offers lush, polished tannins that are maintained by balanced acidity and a long lingering finish. Enjoy now through 2022.

VINEYARD

Doctor's Vineyard is located at about 400-550 ft. in elevation and has a Southeastern exposure. Testarossa currently receives 40 of the 194 acres of Pinot Noir planted at Doctor's. The vineyard was originally planted in 1991 and Testarossa's blocks include more than 10 different Pinot Noir clones. Both Lone Oak and Doctor's are certified sustainable.
