Dense garnet color. Boysenberry, pomegranate, cranberry, cloves, lemon zest, papaya initiate the senses in the first impression. Very complex nose that continues to evolve into fruity, floral, and spice dimensions. While a touch shy now, the flavors are beaming with red fruits, citrus, and spice, in addition to the abundant aromatic qualities. Vibrant acidity and intricate tannins keep the palate engaged for quite some time. The best days for this wine are yet to come. Enjoy now through 2025.
