COVID-19 Vendor Guidelines

Testarossa Winery takes safety as our number one priority. Per Santa Clara County orders and Testarossa Winery policy, all winery vendors must follow the COVID-19 safety precautions outlined below in order to access the winery:

1. Self-assess yourself for COVID-19 symptoms, including taking your temperature, prior to coming on property. Symptoms may include:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
2. Do not come on property if you have any of the above symptoms.
3. Do not come on property if you have had a known exposure to COVID-19 within the past 14 days.
4. If you recently tested positive for COVID-19, please do not come on property unless it's been 14 days since your test, or 7 days since symptoms were gone, whichever is longer.
5. Wear a mask/facial covering.
6. Maintain a 6+ foot social distance from others (no handshaking, etc.).
7. Sanitize or wash your hands upon entry and frequently during your time at the winery.
8. Avoid touching your face (eyes, nose, mouth, etc.).
