Featured Vineyards

Rincon Vineyard, Arroyo Grande Valley

Planted in 1982 and owned by the Talley family, who have farmed Southern San Luis Obispo County for three generations, Rincon Vineyard lies just seven miles northeast of the Pacific Ocean. Its steep terrain and Burgundian soils, reminiscent of the Côte de Nuits, make it one of the most compelling and distinctive sites in the region. A close collaboration between the Talley family and Testarossa's Rob and Diana Jensen, alongside Director of Winemaking Bill Brosseau, brings forward wines of classic old-world character, concentration, and complexity. The Chardonnays open with passionfruit, fig, apple, pear, and coconut, supported by brisk acidity and an intricate, layered texture that carries through a youthful, mineral-driven finish. The Pinot Noirs reveal dense and expressive aromas of clove, sage, cherry, roasted strawberry, papaya, anise, and violet, unfolding into juicy tannins, modest acidity, and a lush, hedonistic finish that lingers gracefully.

Rosemary's Vineyard, Arroyo Grande Valley

Perched above the Pacific Ocean just six miles inland, Rosemary's Vineyard surrounds the home of Talley Vineyards' co-founder, Rosemary Talley. As one of the coolest and most distinctive sites in the Arroyo Grande Valley, its coastal breezes and low yields produce fruit of remarkable balance and purity. A close collaboration between the Talley family and Testarossa's Rob and Diana Jensen, with Director of Winemaking Bill Brosseau, highlights the site's elegant, old-world charm. The Chardonnays show melon, honeysuckle, coconut, mango, and apricot jam layered with gentle oak spice, offering plush texture and a graceful, lingering finish. The Pinot Noirs reveal cherry, sage, raspberry jam, and cranberry, framed by juicy tannins, vibrant acidity, and a refined, precise close.

Soberanes Vineyard, Santa Lucia Highlands

Located in the heart of the Santa Lucia Highlands, Soberanes Vineyard is the fifth and newest site in the Pisoni–Franscioni family partnership. Planted in 2008, the vineyard reflects decades of hands-on experience and a deep commitment to quality winegrowing. Adjacent to Garys' Vineyard and oriented east to northeast at 400 feet in elevation, its rocky, sandy loam soils produce expressive, site-driven wines. A close collaboration between the Pisoni and Franscioni families and Testarossa's Rob and Diana Jensen, alongside Director of Winemaking Bill Brosseau, brings this exceptional site to life. The Chardonnays open with brioche, caramel, ripe fig, and apple, layered with hints of lemon meringue and papaya. Vibrant acidity and a lush, expansive texture lead to an opulent, hedonistic finish. The Pinot Noirs reveal focused aromatics of orange zest, cherry cola, pomegranate, lemon thyme, and papaya, unfolding into juicy tannins, modest acidity, and a plush palate that grows increasingly luscious through the finish.

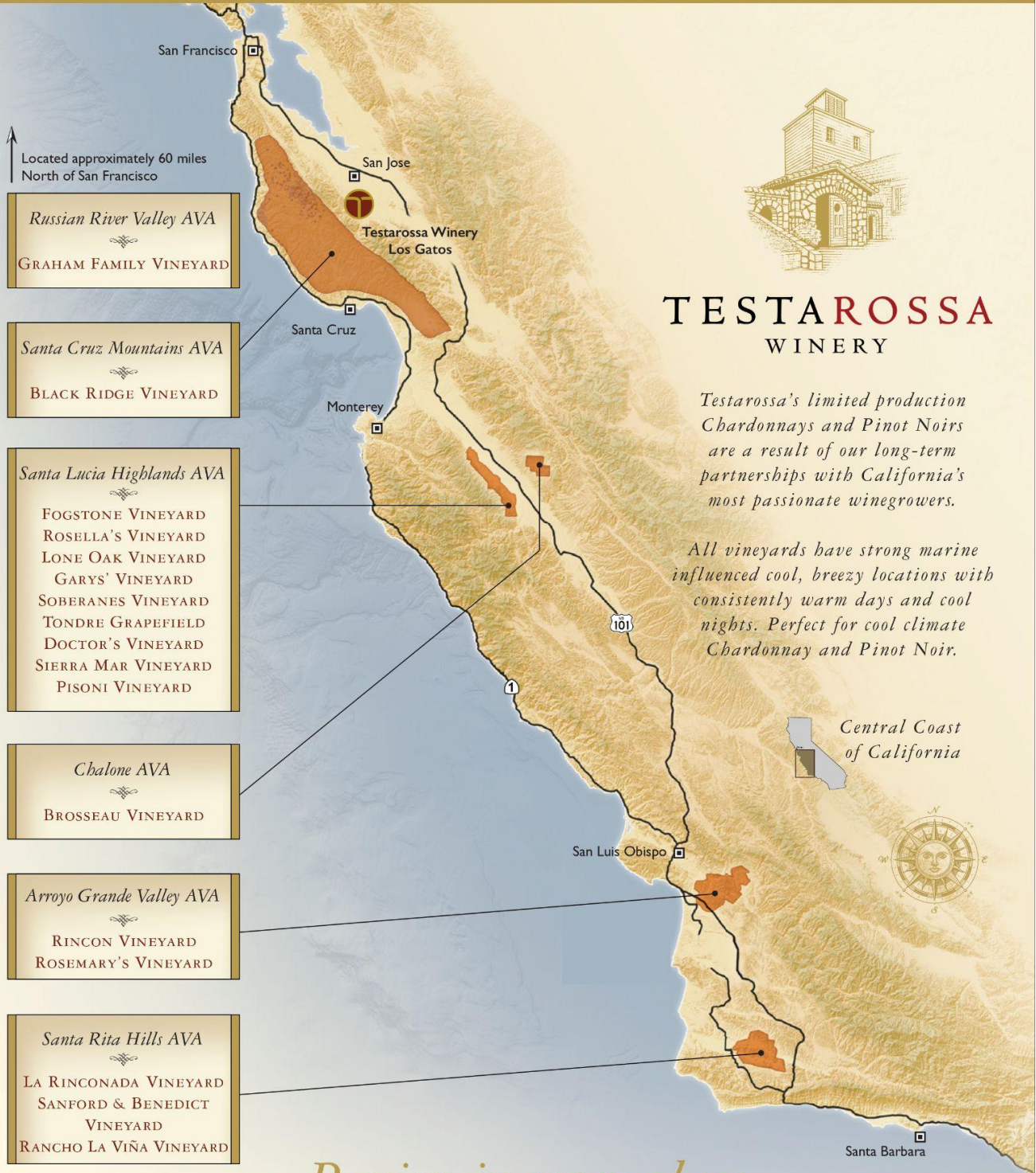

Appellation Summaries

Arroyo Grande Valley

Based in San Luis Obispo County, California, Arroyo Grande is known for producing fine Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes. The climate, during the growing season, is influenced by the close proximity of the Arroyo Grande Valley to the Pacific Ocean. The valley experiences a long dry moderate summer season and a mild winter season. The cool climate and low yields, as well as exceptional soil, lend to the elements that produce acclaimed fruit from this region.

Chalone

The viticultural area is located on a geological bench in the Gabilan (or Gavilan) Mountain Range of Central California, near Salinas Valley. The climate of the Salinas Valley is tempered by the cooling winds from Monterey Bay which form a thick fog layer that extends to an elevation of 1,000 feet (305 m). The soils of the Chalone area has limestone and decomposed granite soil and significantly differ from soils of surrounding areas. The limited rainfall and soil content of limestone and granite contribute to the rich bouquet found in Chalone wines.

Russian River Valley

Located less than 10 miles from the Pacific Ocean, has a climate influenced by cool morning fog from the Petaluma Gap that dissipates during the day. This fog causes significant diurnal temperature variations. The Russian River, which is rain-fed and swells in winter, provides essential irrigation during the dry late spring. Summer warmth is moderated by the fog, allowing for a long ripening period and reducing the risk of overripe flavors in the grapes.

Appellation Summaries

Santa Cruz Mountains

The mountainous Santa Cruz Mountains appellation has been home to our winery since 1888. Cool night and warm sunny days allow for long, slow, full ripening of the fruit. Most wines come from high-altitude, small vineyard, growing on top of an ancient seabed near the Pacific Ocean. These growing conditions give the wines a distinct identity, characterized by fresh flavors, bright fruit, and minerality.

Santa Lucia Highlands

Santa Lucia Highlands is one of the state's best-known regions for world-class Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. The area's proximity to Monterey Bay makes for a very cool climate, with one of California's longest growing seasons. The resulting slow, gentle ripening allows for full flavor development on the vine. Testarossa's production team's partnership with the best estates in the Santa Lucia Highlands ensure only the highest quality fruit makes it to the winery.

Santa Rita Hills

The Santa Rita Hills appellation is one the unique places where the valleys run east-west opening up toward the Pacific Ocean near Lompoc in Santa Barbara County. The valley is nestled between the Purisima Hills and the Santa Rosa Hills with the Santa Ynez river running through it. Fog and cool, ocean breezes coupled with wind and soils that limit vine vigor add to intense flavor in cool climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Testarossa has been making wine from the Santa Rita Hills since 2004.
