## Featured Vineyards

### La Rinconada Vineyard, Santa Rita Hills

Planted in 1997, La Rinconada Vineyard lies adjacent to the famed Sanford & Benedict Vineyard, one of the foundational sites of the Sta. Rita Hills appellation. Sharing the same marine influence, soils, and cool climate that make Sanford & Benedict ideal for Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, La Rinconada produces wines of depth, balance, and coastal character. The vineyard includes 11 acres of Pinot Noir and 9 acres of Chardonnay planted on clay loam soils at elevations between roughly 235 and 510 feet. Testarossa Winery has crafted both Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from this site since 2012.

### Rancho La Viña Vineyard, Santa Rita Hills

Planted in 2005, the 35-acre Rancho La Viña Vineyard sits on a north-facing slope at the southern edge of the Sta. Rita Hills. Its proximity to the Pacific Ocean brings a strong maritime influence, ensuring cool summers and an extended growing season ideal for Pinot Noir. Silty loam soils contribute to wines with expressive aromatics and bright structure. The ranch itself has been family-owned since the 1860s and is part of the historic Santa Rosa Land Grant. In addition to premium Pinot Noir, the property also produces organic walnuts and heirloom tomatoes. Testarossa Winery has crafted Pinot Noir from this vineyard since the 2020 vintage.

### Sanford & Benedict Vineyard, Santa Rita Hills

Located near Lompoc in the renowned Santa Rita Hills appellation, Sanford & Benedict Vineyard is one of the most influential vineyards in the region. Originally planted by Richard Sanford, the site helped establish the Santa Rita Hills as a premier area for cool-climate Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Testarossa Winery first produced wines from this vineyard in 2004 and today receives fruit from select blocks, including approximately six of the vineyard's sixteen acres of Pinot Noir and four of its twenty-eight acres of Chardonnay. Sitting at about 400 feet in elevation with a northern exposure, the vineyard's gravelly loam soils mixed with clay and fragmented chert, combined with strong ocean winds funneled inland from the Pacific, create ideal conditions for producing structured, expressive wines with vibrant acidity and coastal character.

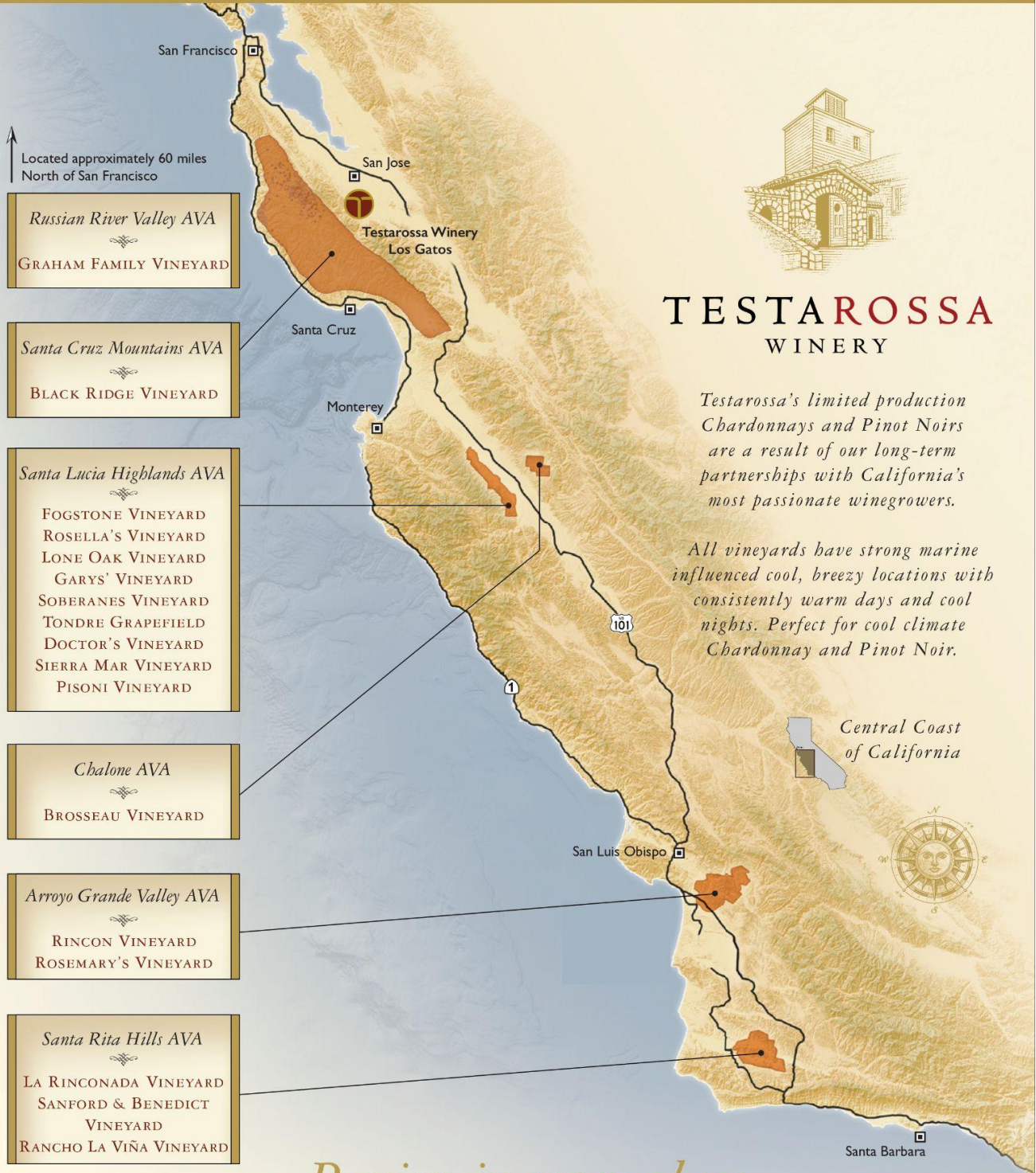

# Appellation Summaries

## Arroyo Grande Valley

---

Based in San Luis Obispo County, California, Arroyo Grande is known for producing fine Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes. The climate, during the growing season, is influenced by the close proximity of the Arroyo Grande Valley to the Pacific Ocean. The valley experiences a long dry moderate summer season and a mild winter season. The cool climate and low yields, as well as exceptional soil, lend to the elements that produce acclaimed fruit from this region.

## Chalone

---

The viticultural area is located on a geological bench in the Gabilan (or Gavilan) Mountain Range of Central California, near Salinas Valley. The climate of the Salinas Valley is tempered by the cooling winds from Monterey Bay which form a thick fog layer that extends to an elevation of 1,000 feet (305 m). The soils of the Chalone area has limestone and decomposed granite soil and significantly differ from soils of surrounding areas. The limited rainfall and soil content of limestone and granite contribute to the rich bouquet found in Chalone wines.

## Russian River Valley

---

Located less than 10 miles from the Pacific Ocean, has a climate influenced by cool morning fog from the Petaluma Gap that dissipates during the day. This fog causes significant diurnal temperature variations. The Russian River, which is rain-fed and swells in winter, provides essential irrigation during the dry late spring. Summer warmth is moderated by the fog, allowing for a long ripening period and reducing the risk of overripe flavors in the grapes.

# Appellation Summaries

## Santa Cruz Mountains

---

The mountainous Santa Cruz Mountains appellation has been home to our winery since 1888. Cool night and warm sunny days allow for long, slow, full ripening of the fruit. Most wines come from high-altitude, small vineyard, growing on top of an ancient seabed near the Pacific Ocean. These growing conditions give the wines a distinct identity, characterized by fresh flavors, bright fruit, and minerality.

## Santa Lucia Highlands

---

Santa Lucia Highlands is one of the state's best-known regions for world-class Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. The area's proximity to Monterey Bay makes for a very cool climate, with one of California's longest growing seasons. The resulting slow, gentle ripening allows for full flavor development on the vine. Testarossa's production team's partnership with the best estates in the Santa Lucia Highlands ensure only the highest quality fruit makes it to the winery.

## Santa Rita Hills

---

The Santa Rita Hills appellation is one the unique places where the valleys run east-west opening up toward the Pacific Ocean near Lompoc in Santa Barbara County. The valley is nestled between the Purisima Hills and the Santa Rosa Hills with the Santa Ynez river running through it. Fog and cool, ocean breezes coupled with wind and soils that limit vine vigor add to intense flavor in cool climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Testarossa has been making wine from the Santa Rita Hills since 2004.
